The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the tentative apportionment of benefit for each parcel and municipality within the Intercounty Drainage District.

The Drain Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day, and make revisions where necessary. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Intercounty Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner of their County at the number listed above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's determination of apportionments to the Probate Court in the county in which you reside within ten (10) days.

The following is a description of the several tracts or parcels of lands constituting the Special Assessment District of the Indian Creek Intercounty Drain, as well as a list of any county, township, city, village to be assessed at large:

Lands situated in Sections 1-24 and 27-32, T.10N.-R.11E. Burlington Township and Section 19, T.10N.-R.12E. Burnside Township and Sections 24-25 and 36, T.10N.-R.12E. Rich Township, Lapeer County, Michigan and lands situated in Sections 5-8 and 17-18, T.10N.-R.12E. Marlette Township, Sanilac County, Michigan and lands situated in Sections 25 and 36, T.11N.-R.10E., Dayton Township and Sections 19 and 29-35, T.11N.-R.11E., Koylton Township. Also Burlington Township, Burnside Township, Village of Clifford, Dayton Township, Koylton Township, Marlette Township and Rich Township for benefits to public health, convenience and welfare, and Lapeer County, Tuscola County, and Sanilac County for benefits to county roads and the Village of Clifford for benefits to village streets.
