

STREET MAINTENANCE MILLAGE
PROPOSAL**

Shall the limitation upon the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed upon real and tangible personal property for all purposes in any one year under Michigan law be increased for the Village of Mayville, Tuscola County, Michigan, by two mills (\$2.00 per one thousand dollars), to provide additional funds for street maintenance and repair with in the Village, which exceeds the 15 mill limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of Michigan Constitution on General Ad Valorem Taxes within the Village of Mayville, for ten years, from 2009 through 2018, which levy will raise in the first year of the levy the estimated sum of \$34,005.00.
