Statement of Reason:

Renae Schnettler has failed to carry out her duties as Vassar Township Clerk by refusing to attend Township Board meetings, refusing to post meeting minutes on the Township website or at the Township Hall, refusing to work the number of office hours performed by previous clerks, and refusing to cooperate with the Township auditor in preparing the mandatory annual audit of Township funds.

Justification of Conduct:

This recall is about revenge. The former Vassar Township Board fired our current supervisor, Bob Forbes, while he was Zoning Administrator in March 2008. The vote was 4-1. I made the motion to terminate his employment, so Mr. Forbes and his wife, Yvonne have vowed to destroy my professional reputation and career. Donald and Onna Clinesmith are also seeking revenge because I turned them in for zoning violations. The Clinesmiths mined their property without a permit in 1999, 2004 and 2008. They refused to comply with state and local laws, which greatly impacted their neighbors and resulted in costly consequences for everyone involved. It is unfortunate that the Forbes' and the Clinesmiths' continue to harrass public officials at every level of government to further their own agendas.
