Tuscola County will be accepting bids on the replacement of all existing fencing, concrete pad replacement, and the installation of a new barrier fence at the front and rear kennels at the County Animal Shelter at 2738 W. Caro Rd, Caro MI 48723. The following specifications shall be considered in your bid:

- 1. Contractor shall be responsible for any needed permits or plans.
- 2. Contractor shall field verify measurements.
- 3. Contractor shall remove all existing interior and exterior fencing and gates.
- 4. New gates to be installed on interior of kennel area. New gates to fit in existing kennels openings.
- 5. Contractor shall remove rear concrete pad/sidewalk and repair floor drain. A new 4-inch concrete pad with wire mesh and sidewalk installed to existing dimensions.
 - Existing floor drain and shut off to be removed and new floor drain (PVC Piping) is to be installed and reconnected to sewer.
- 6. Contractor shall install new barrier fencing at front and rear kennels to prevent public access to the animals.
- 7. Contractor shall install new fencing from the new rear barrier fence to the existing rear property fence, to create a dog run. This fencing shall be a minimum of 6 feet high and shall include an 8-foot wide rolling gate for mower access.

- 8. All new fencing and gates shall be commercial grade 9 Gage minimum, 2-inch mesh, and hot dipped galvanized. Structure shall also be commercial grade, piping thickness of .80 minimum. New fence shall be installed to the current dimensions of kennels.
- All terminal and line post shall be cemented in the ground. Fence installation will include stretching and final tension should allow for a slight amount of give when squeezed by hand.
- Contractor is responsible for clean up of job site each day and disposal old material.

Contract shall provide proof of liability and workmen's comp insurance. Before work begins.

Only qualified personnel shall be use to complete projects
