Courthouse X-Ray Machine Maintenance Agreement Renewal

History:

The existing x-ray machine was purchased from Event Metal Detectors/X-Ray Machines in December 2013 in the amount of \$25,600.00. The project was funded entirely with a Homeland Security grant.

Court Security uses the x-ray machine Monday through Friday while the courthouse is open to the public. (Obviously Covid has changed this practice)

Since being in operation, we have utilized the service contract on several occasions to repair the x-ray machine. To date, we have replaced the belt, rollers, on board computer, had misc repairs made to the control panel, and other components.

With the many mergers with L-3/Harris and the initial service technician leaving the company, it has been increasingly difficult to work with our existing x-ray machine vendor for maintenance and servicing. This, along with the ever increasing cost of the annual maintenance contract I attempted to get some additional options for the Board to consider.

Option A: Continue with L-3/Harris which is now Leidos

- L-3/Harris was purchased by Leidos at some point in 2020.
- I requested a quote for the annual service agreement for the existing x-ray machine and was able to get one after learning that the company was bought out and their email addresses were changed. For one year of coverage (March 25, 2021 thru March 24, 2021) the price was quoted at \$5,800.00.
- This is an increase from the \$5,500.00 that we paid last year.
- To date we have paid (2016-2020) \$24,500.00 for the annual service contract.

Option B:VOTI Detection

- Provided pricing on two different units
 - XR3D-50s: Total with 5 yr service contract & training = \$42,260.00
 - XR3D-60s: Total with 5 yr service contract & training = \$44,610.00
- Also provided leasing pricing for both units as well

 - \$1,088.20 per month (\$13,058.40 per year / 3 yr total \$39,175.20) with a buyout of 15.5% (\$6,550.30)

- \$710.39 per month (\$8,524.68 per year / 5 yr total \$42,623.40) with a buyout of 10.1% (\$4,268.26)

 - 36 month:
 - \$1,148.71 per month (\$13,784.52 per year / 3 yr total \$41,353.56) with a buyout of 15.5 % (\$6,914.55)

 - 60 month:
 - \$749.89 per month (\$8,998.68 per year / 3 yr total \$44,993.40) with a buyout of 10.1% (\$4,505.61)

Option C: MSA Security

- Provided pricing on two different units
 - HI-SCAN 5030si with 3 yr service contract \$36,312.00
 - HI-SCAN 6040ds with 3 yr service contract \$48,356.00
- Leasing was not available because of COVID

Option D: Point Security, Inc

- Provide service for several makes/models of x-ray machines. Was advised that they no longer service L-3/Harris as they had difficulty in receiving parts from the manufacturer in a timely manner. Phased out all service contract with L-3/Harris machines in the last year
- Provided pricing on two different units
 - Smith Detection 5030si with 5 yr service contract \$40,010.00
 - Smith Detection 6040ds with 5 yr service contract \$43,754.00
- Also provided leasing pricing for both units as well for a 60 month/5 yr lease
 - Smith Detection 5030si or the 6040ds: \$9,000.00 per year / 5 year total \$45,000.00

Option E: Autoclear, LLC

- I spoke with a salesperson who recently dealt with Lapeer County, Greg Schaefer. Greg advised they do not service L-3/Harris machines but knows someone who might who is based out of Chicago.
- I was contacted by Sal Leanos, owner of Advance Security Resources. After sending the information about the current x-ray machine we own, he declined to service the machine, citing that the parts are currently being shipped from China.

 I was supposed to receive a quote/proposal from Autoclear/Advance Security Resources, but as of yet, I have not received anything. January 14, 2021

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ANNUAL EQUIPMENT HARDWARE MAINTENANCE CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Document No. 8100-11901-00

- <u>Cross Indemnification</u>: Leidos Security Detection & Automation Inc., hereinafter referred to as Seller, shall indemnify, defend and hold Buyer harmless from and against any losses, damages, expenses, liabilities, and costs arising out of the negligence of Seller, its employees, or agents in performing services under this Agreement. Buyer shall indemnify, defend and hold Seller harmless from and against any losses, damages, expenses, liabilities, and costs arising out of the negligence of Buyer, its employees, or agents with respect to the use or operation of the System.
- <u>Cancellation during the contract period</u>: If Buyer cancels this Agreement pursuant to Section three (3) or if newly purchased equipment supplied by Seller replaces the equipment under this contract. Buyer may cancel this contract without charge by giving written notice to Seller. In the case of a cancellation for any other reason, Buyer must provide Seller ninety (90) days' prior written notice of cancellation or pay Seller 25% of any remaining annual contract fee as liquidated damages. Seller also reserves the right to cancel this Agreement without penalty if Buyer is in default and fails to cure within 30 days following receipt of written notice of default.
- 3. <u>Cancellation for cause</u>: Buyer retains the right to cancel this contract immediately and without advance notice to Seller should Seller's services be unsatisfactory in quality or should Seller fail to perform in accordance with the statement of services for any reason within Seller's control. In the event of such cancellation, Buyer will notify Seller in writing. Buyer will pay only for the services rendered up to the date that Seller receives the written cancellation notice.
- 4. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: REGARDLESS OF THE LEGAL OR EQUITABLE BASIS OF ANY CLAIM, IN NO EVENT WILL SELLER BE LIABLE FOR (I) ANY SPECIAL, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY DAMAGES RESULTING FROM INACCURATE OR LOSS OF USS OF USE OR LOSS OF REVENUES OR PROFITS, ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT OR ANY ORDER, THE FURNISHING OF PRODUCTS AND SERVICES OR THE USE OR PERFORMANCE OF PRODUCTS OR SERVICES, EVEN IF INFORMED OF SUCH DAMAGES, OR (II) FOR ANY THIRD PARTY CLAIMS AGAINST CUSTOMER. SELLER'S MAXIMUM LIABILITY UNDER ANY ORDER, INCLUDING LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF PRODUCTS DELIVERED, SERVICES PERFORMED OR FROM SELLER'S MAXIMUM LIABILITY UNDER ANY ORDER, INCLUDING LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF PRODUCTS DELIVERED, SERVICES PERFORMED OR FROM SELLER'S MAXIMUM LIABILITY UNDER ANY ORDER, INCLUDING LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF PRODUCTS DELIVERED, SERVICES PERFORMED OR FROM SELLER'S MAXIMUM CON THE ACTS OR OMISSIONS, WILL BE LIMITED TO THE AMOUNT PAID TO SELLER FOR THE PRODUCTS AND/OR SERVICES GIVING RISE TO THE CLAIM.
- 5. <u>Alterations</u>: Buyer shall have the right to request that systems be returned to service coverage on a pro-rated basis. Prior to systems being returned to service coverage all systems are subject to billable pre-inspection services to be performed by the Seller. The Seller's prevailing standard service rates shall be used to calculate the pre-inspection services.
- 6. <u>Software:</u> Unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing to the contrary, all technical specifications, software, technical information, source code, drawings, and/or Data provided to Buyer by the Seller, or used by the Seller in updating, upgrading or performing repairs to the Buyer's equipment, shall remain the sole property of the Seller. Any use of said data and software shall constitute use under a limited use license only. This License is expressly limited to the functionality of individual items of Seller equipment previously purchased by the Buyer.
- 7. <u>Exclusions:</u> Contractual coverage shall not apply to any equipment, spare parts, or services that are: (a) repaired, moved or modified other than by Seller's authorized personnet; or (b) subjected to physical or electrical abuse, stress, or misuse; or (c) stored, operated, modified, or maintained in a manner inconsistent with applicable Seller instructions and specifications. No third party agents, regardless of affiliation or former affiliation with Seller, retain the rights to perform service actions under this contract. Also excluded from this contract are parts, materials, and other ancillary equipment which have been damaged due to improper handling; power surges, exposure to the elements of extreme heat, extreme cold, moisture; acts of nature such as rain, sleet, snow, earthquakes, lightning, hurricane, etc.; equipment failures resulting from installation or operation or use in any manner not in accordance with Seller instructions; failures resulting from installation or operation or use in any manner not in accordance with Seller instructions; equipment damage due to misuse or abuse (through negligence, accident, or vandalism); erroneous reports by Buyer of equipment failures; and equipment which has been repaired or modified without the written approval of Seller.
- 8. <u>Accessories and Attachments</u>: Service actions performed by Seller under this contract will not include maintenance or repair of accessories, attachments, machines, or other similar devices not originally supplied or provided by Seller; painting or refinishing of equipment or providing such painting or refinishing materials; or furnishing supplies, accessories, or other similar devices except as specifically required for equipment repair or maintenance.
- 9. Special Cancellation: The specific equipment covered by this contract shall be serviced as needed and all required spare parts shall be provided unless stock is no longer available due to end of life issues. Seller shall make a best commercial effort to support this equipment during the contractual period and make provisions for end of life parts. Should services be required and spare parts are no longer available. Seller shall make a best commercial effort to render Buyer's equipment back into operating condition. If Seller is unable to bring the up to operating condition, the affected equipment shall then be removed from the remainder of the contract and a pro-rated credit for the balance of the present contract term shall be issued. Credits shall be sent out within thirty (30) days of cancellation. Also, the affected equipment shall not be included in future contract renewals or during any remaining optional years.
- <u>Taxes</u>: This quotation does not include taxes. Taxes levied against Seller as a result of products offered or sold hereunder and any services rendered in connection therewith, including but not limited to installation or maintenance would be additional cost and shall be reimbursable by Purchaser upon submittal of supporting documentation of such costs.

- <u>Response Time</u>: Leidos Security Detection & Automation Inc., hereinafter referred to as Seller, will provide response as soon as possible to requests for equipment service from Buyer's authorized representative. 8-hour Seller response time will be typical in geographical locations where Seller has resident service engineers. 24-hour Seller response time will be typical in geographical locations where Seller does not have resident service engineers. Seller does not warrant that the use of equipment will be uninterrupted or error free.
- 2. <u>Seller Responsibilities</u>: As applicable to the specific maintenance contract schedule, service actions performed by Seller will include all parts, materials, and labor required to adjust, maintain, repair, or restore the equipment to proper operating condition in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications. Seller will not perform any modifications to the equipment without Buyer's written approval. Seller will perform all service actions with the least possible interference or disruption to the orderly conduct of Buyer's normal operations. Upon the completion of service, Seller will leave Buyer's premises in as neat, orderly, and clean condition as existed upon start of services. Seller will be responsible for obtaining all air side passes, work permits, clearances, and required licenses. Seller will be responsible for compliance with all laws, codes, rules, and regulations applicable to services performed under this contract. Seller will not transfer or assign its obligations under this contract, either in whole or in part, without the prior written approval of Buyer.
- <u>Buver Responsibilities</u>: Buyer will provide adequate facilities for Setter's personnel. The facilities will include adequate workspace, heat, lighting, ventilation, proper electrical current, and earth grounded electrical outlets. The facilities will be located within a reasonable distance from the equipment being serviced and will be provided by Buyer at no cost to Setter's current, setter will not be responsible for Buyer's failure to provide prompt access to the equipment or to adequate facilities.
- 4. <u>Additional Services</u>: Upon agreement between Buyer and Seller, Seller may parform additional services beyond Seller's obligations under this contract. Such services may include, but are not limited to, equipment installation, relocation, and re-installation. Should Buyer fail to have an authorized representative is signature on the SCR will not be a basis for claiming that unsatisfactory service was provided by Seller.
- 6. <u>Spare Parts and Materials</u>: All spare parts and materials provided and or replaced by the Seller, regardless if they are new; factory refurbished, rebuilt, restored, renovated or reconditioned, shall be warranted for ninety (90) days from the date of installation. 



EXHIBIT A MAP SHOWING SUBJECT PROPERTY AREAS
