

INFORMATION ON JUDGE

Amanda L. Roggenbuck is the Tuscola County Probate Judge, and presiding Family Court Judge. She is the first female to hold the office of Judge in Tuscola County. Prior to becoming a judge, she owned and operated Amanda L. Roggenbuck and Associates, PLLC for several years and also served as a local official. Roggenbuck devoted much of her law practice to family law, abuse and neglect law, and estate planning. Roggenbuck was born and raised in the thumb on a dairy and cash crop farm that her family still owns and operates. She did her undergraduate studies at Michigan State University and received her degree in political science. She completed law school at Cooley Law School by attending the weekend program.

Judge Roggenbuck has one child, a four year old son named Parker, and her husband is a police officer. She enjoys traveling, and spending time with her family. Roggenbuck has worked in various areas of the legislature. First as a Michigan House of Representative page; an assistant to then Senator Bill Schuette; and, a legislative liaison to former Representative Tom Meyer. Roggenbuck has completed LEAD Tuscola, White House Project, and Michigan Political Leadership Program.

Judge Roggenbuck, is constantly working to reshape how the Probate Court operates in light of the fact that everyone is being asked to do more with less. She has reduced paid staff and supplemented it with interns and continues to seek grants to incorporate technology. Judge Roggenbuck has already received a grant to incorporate video conferencing equipment. That equipment reduces both long and short term costs and increases security.
