The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the Gagetown Drain Drainage District boundaries and the tentative apportionment of benefits for each parcel and municipality within the drainage district with the Drain Commissioner or staff member. A map of the proposed drainage district boundary revisions can be found attached to this notice and on the Drain Commissioner's website at: <https://www.tuscolacounty.org/drain/>.

The following is a list of any county, township, city, or village to be assessed: Tuscola County, Elkland Township, and the Village of Gagetown.

Attendance at the Day of Review:

- No appointment is necessary.
- The Drain Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals and make revisions where necessary.
- The computation of costs for the Drain will be available.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner's Office at (989) 672-3820 (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing, or other assistance.

Submitting Comments

Comments on the apportionment of benefits may be submitted in writing or verbally at the Day of Review. Comments may also be submitted in writing before the date of the Day of Review to:

Comments submitted in advance must be received by the Drain Commissioner prior to the Day of Review to ensure that they will be considered.

Assessments & Appeal

Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, then at any time you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date, which will avoid further interest charges.

You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Tuscola County Circuit Court within ten (10) days. You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's determination of apportionments to the Tuscola County Probate Court within ten (10) days.

Notice of Letting

The following additional information can be found on the Notice of Bid Letting on the Drain Commissioner's website at: <https://www.tuscolacounty.org/drain/>:

- A description of the lands constituting the drainage district;
- Number and length of sections, the average width and depth of each section, and if the drain will be closed, the amount and specifications of all tile or pipe required;
- Location, number, type, and size of culverts or bridges to be installed, if any; and
- Conditions upon which the contract will be awarded.
