AKRON-FAIRGROVE SCHOOLS
BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Akron-Fairgrove Schools, Tuscola County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Three Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,100,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

remodeling, furnishing and refurbishing and equipping and re-equipping school buildings; acquiring, installing and equipping and re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; purchasing school buses; and developing and improving athletic facilities and sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2014 is 2 mills (\$2.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation), for a net -0- mill increase from the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is ten (10) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 1.73 mills (\$1.73 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
