- EMS Director Patrick Finn was requested at the scene of a bomb threat at the Caro High School. The Homeland Security Bomb dog from Vassar PD was used to determine it was not a creditable threat and the school was searched and classes resumed.

He was requested at 5160 Barnes Road in Millington Twp where a missing child had been reported. While en route, the missing child had been located and the family was taken to the Hospital to be checked. He was also requested on Deckerville Road, west of Deford to the other tornado touch down. He partially activated the EOC and contacted the American Red Cross to assist the families affected. He did damage assessments for the areas, and reported the information to the BOARD Chairperson and other elected officials. Once it became daylight another damage assessment was done to both of the affected areas and reports to the nation Weather Service which confirmed both tornado touchdowns were F-1 tornados.

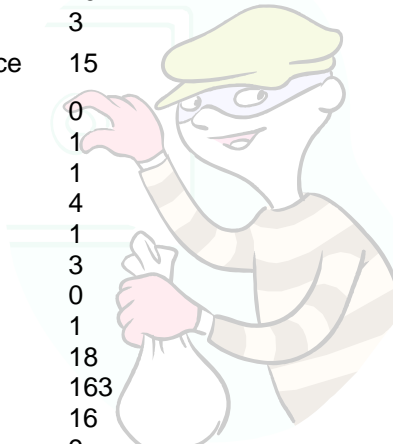
