MONTHLY REPORT - 2008

TUSCOLA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE



- February 1 EMS Director Patrick Finn, 38 other first responders, and public officials participated in Federal Incident Management IS400 class at Hills and Dales hospital in Cass City.
- February 4 EMS Director Patrick Finn and the Caro FD Chief attended the Michigan State Police Emergency Management Homeland Security Division E-Team and Resource Typing entry training workshop in Bay City.
- EMS Director Patrick Finn attended the Michigan 3rd District Homeland Security Regional Planning Board meeting in Bay City.
- February 7 There was a major snowstorm in Tuscola County with over 18 inches of snow in the Vassar area, the rest of the county had averaged just under 12 inches. The EOC Emergency Operations Center was partially activated and through a Unified Command decision the vice Chair shut down county services for safety reasons. The proper Agency and Department heads were advised and a Public Service announcement was given to the news media. The EOC monitored the weather situation and the EOC was deactivated at about 5 pm once the weather cleared up and road conditions began to improve.
- February 9-11 Sheriff Thomas T. Kern, Detective Sergeant Glen Skrent, Coporal Brian Harris, C/O Jason Fullerton, Deputies Michael Mattlin and Steve Roland participated in "Cops Helping Cops" and helped rebuild a house for a fellow officer who had lost everything in the Katrina Hurricane in New Orleans.
- February 11 Undersheriff James Jashinske attended the Tuscola County Gun Board meeting.
- February 12 EMS Director Patrick Finn was call to assist the Caro Police and Fire Departments at the scene of an accident of two semi trucks on M-81 and the Wal-Mart entrance. One of the trucks had leaked about 150 gallons of diesel fuel on the roadway. Michigan DEQ Officials, TC Health Department, and other agencies responded or were notified. The Sheriff's Department assisted Caro PD with traffic and the Tuscola County Road Commission set up barricades to reroute traffic until a proper environmental company could respond for the necessary clean up of the fuel. It took about 7 hours to clear the road way.
- February 20 Sheriff Thomas T. Kern attended the Employee Input Committee meeting at the Courthouse.

- February 21 Sheriff Thomas T. Kern met with the new manager of the Ethanol Plant.
- February 22 The Tuscola County Office of Emergency Management with the assistance of the Tuscola County Radio Civil Emergency Services (Ham Operators) gave a presentation about Emergency Management to 17 Vassar High School Government students in the County Emergency Operations Center, the students also were given a tour of the Jail and Courthouse.
- February 25 Undersheriff James Jashinske and Lieutenant Leland Teschendorf attended the 2008 Boy Scout Leadership Banquet at JJ Jamokes.
- February 26 Undersheriff James Jashinske and Deputy Ryan Pierce met with the Safe Communities Committee.
- February 29 Sheriff Thomas T. Kern attended a Caro Rotary Banquet in Frankenmuth.

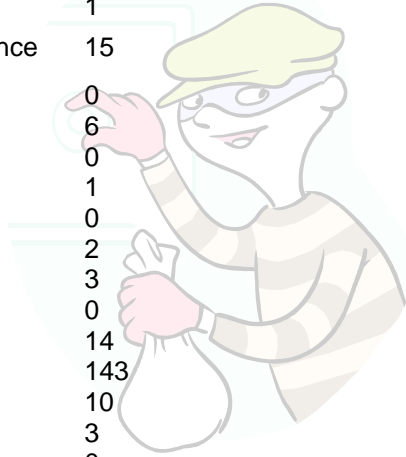
