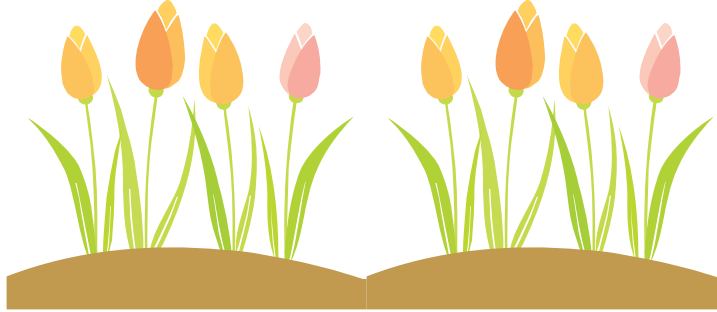


TUSCOLA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MONTHLY REPORT

- April 30 Sheriff Thomas T. Kern and Lieutenant Leland Teschendorf met with a Senior Citizen group at the Arbela Township Hall.

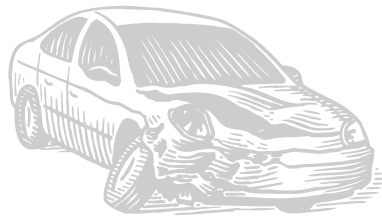

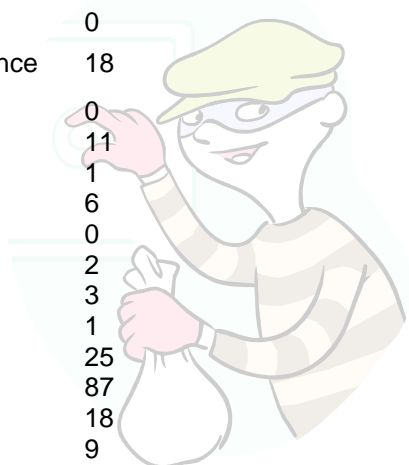
