- April 29 Undersheriff James attended the 3rd District Law Enforcement Regional Terrorism meeting at the Hampton Township Hall.


PEM Director Patrick Finn attended the Village of Caro after action critique meeting involving the Village Manager and staff at the Caro Village Hall.


