- May 29 Sheriff Thomas T. Kern and several staff members attended an explosive recognition class at the Tuscola Technology Center.

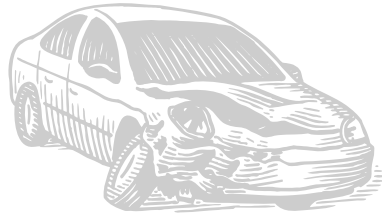

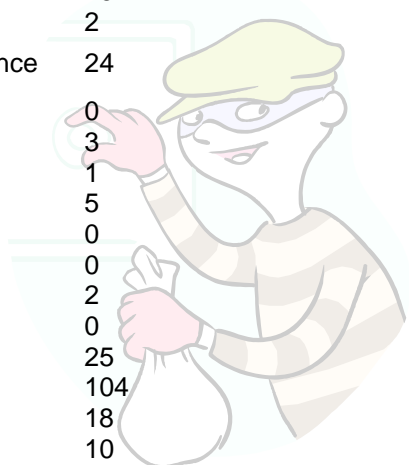
