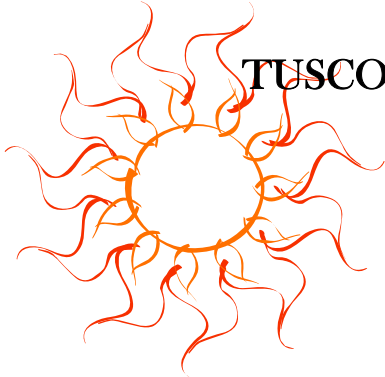


TUSCOLA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MONTHLY REPORT 2008

TUSCOLA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE



- June 1 PEM Director Patrick Finn attended the 3rd District informational meeting in the morning and the Region 3 Michigan Homeland Security Planning Board meeting in the afternoon in Bay City.
- June 3 Lieutenant Leland Teschendorf did a presentation at Highland Pines School for Ms. Henry's class of 11 students.
- June 3-5 Detective Sergeant Glen Skrent attended Interviewing the Sexual Deviant training in Burton, MI.
- June 4 Undersheriff James Jashinske attended the Tuscola County Police Chief's Association meeting.
- Tuscola County Emergency Management and Tuscola Fire Chiefs conducted their monthly TORNADO SIREN TESTS.
- June 5 PEM Director Patrick Finn served as a mock disaster exercise evaluator for the Regional multi-county exercise for Alcona, Iosco and Oscoda called Downstream Danger that involved the breaching of the Mio Dam that ended downstream until it actually floods the Village of Oscoda. It was a great exercise and many lessons were learned during the incident.
- June 6 Lieutenant Leland Teschendorf attended the MMRA summer conference in Gaylord, MI.
- June 7, 8, 9 & 10, 2008 Undersheriff James Jashinske and Lieutenant Leland Teschendorf attended the Michigan Sheriff's Association conference at Shanty Creek in Bellaire, MI.
- June 10 Tuscola County Health Department and Emergency Management conducted a mock disaster drill involving the portable generator purchased with Homeland Security grant funds. The generator was moved to a predisposed location and actually activated for half an hour under a load during a rainstorm. Many valuable lessons were revealed to better prepare in the unlikely event we need to use it.
- June 11 Lieutenant Leland Teschendorf attended the Kirtland Community College's Corrections Consortium Meeting that was held on their campus.

- June 12 Lieutenant Leland Teschendorf and Corrections Officer Rod Bertsch attended the Thumb Area Community Corrections Advisory Board meeting in Caro.
- June 13 PEM Director Patrick Finn and all Tuscola County first responders participated in the Civil Defense Network Test.
- June 15 Tuscola County was under a Severe Thunderstorm Watch and Tornado Warning. We had numerous trees, limbs and power lines down with several hundred people out of power that lasted several days.
- June 17 PEM Director Patrick Finn attended two separate meetings at the Caro Center concerning the Reverse 911 Grant, presentations were given by two separate vendors, Code spear and Reverse 911.
- June 18 PEM Director Patrick Finn attended the Region 3 Michigan Homeland Security Exercise Planning committee meeting at the Bay County EOC.
- June 20 Sheriff Thomas Kern was the MC at the Senior Fair which was held at the Caro High School.
- June 24 Sheriff Thomas Kern, Lieutenant Leland Teschendorf, Corporal Brian Harris, and Corporal Mark House met with Tuscola Behavioral Health Systems official's to reference jail issues.
- June 25 PEM Director Patrick Finn along with several other first responders that included the Sheriff's Department: Sergeant Scott Jones, Fire, EMS, Health Department and local hospitals' staff attended the Region 3 Healthcare Preparedness Network Mass Fatalities workshop at the Dow Event Center in Saginaw.
- June 27 PEM Director Patrick Finn was notified of the Severe Thunderstorm Watch and Tornado Warning for Tuscola County.

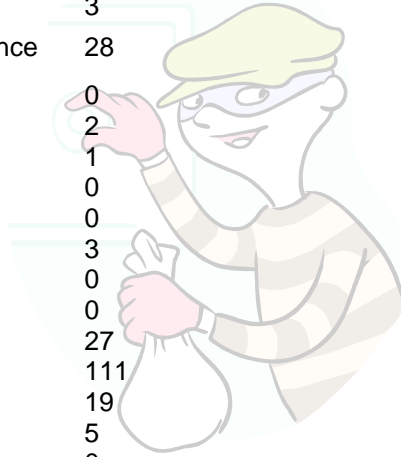
