Sheriff Leland Teschendorf and Undersheriff Glen Skrent attended the Tuscola County TRIAD meeting at the Brentwood.

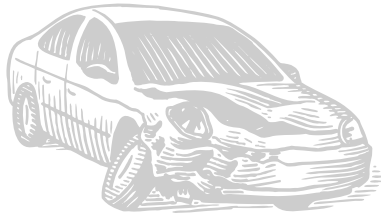

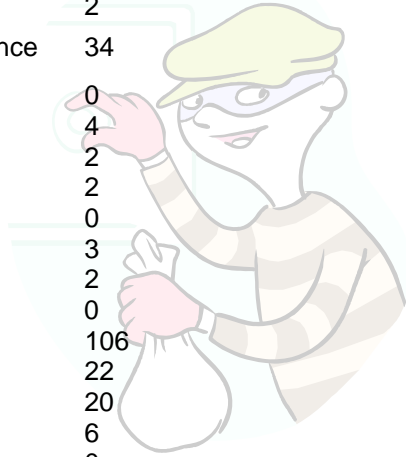
