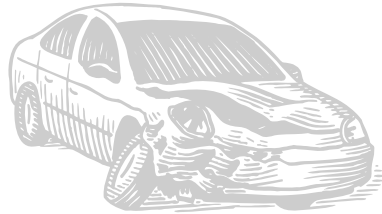
Sergeants Justin Sieveke and Brian Harris attended "Navigating the Disciplinary Process" training.
