- June 22 Sheriff Leland Teschendorf attended the Prevention of Underage Drinking Coalition meeting.

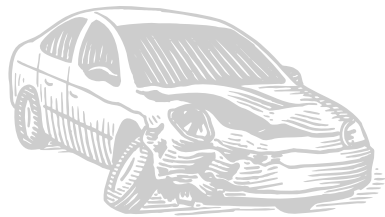

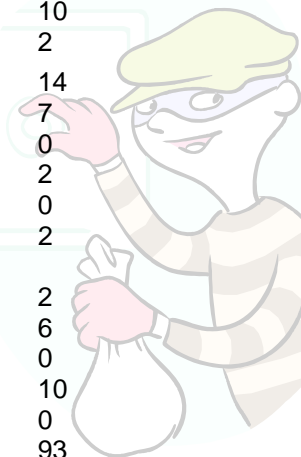
