- Dec 03 PEM Patrick Finn was paged about an injured man caught in a grain auger at Star of the West Milling Co in Reese who was about 70 feet in the air. Reese FD, MMR, SVMCA, Star of the West (bin rescue personnel) and Caro FD ladder truck along with Reese PD assisted at the scene. The victim was rescued and taken to the hospital successfully because of prior training with Fire Departments, Star Employees (Bin Rescue team), and EMS working together.

- Dec 29 Sheriff Leland Teschendorf and Deputy Mike Scarborough attended the Arbela Township Social Club luncheon.

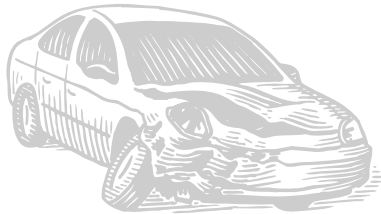
