- Feb 1 Pat Finn was advised by 911/TCCD of a NGL (natural gas leak) in the Village of Reese. Consumers was on scene and no need for a response
- Feb 1 Pat Finn participated in 3rd District monthly State MSPERMHSD radio testing for all 14 counties Emergency Operations Centers. Tuscola also tests with local Public Health & Tuscola Central Dispatch on the same day. The monthly testing of the Tuscola County Homeland Security portable generator was completed.

- Feb 2 Pat Finn was notified by 911/TCCD of a possible gas leak on M-25/Bay Park, it was verified that the propane company was filling a tanker and they had a normal release of propane while unhooking it and no response was needed.

- Feb 23 Sheriff Leland Teschendorf attended the BB/BS luncheon for bowl-a-thon information

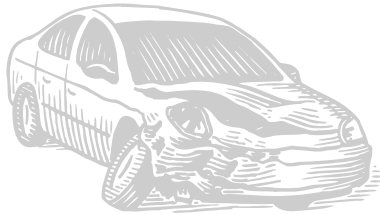
