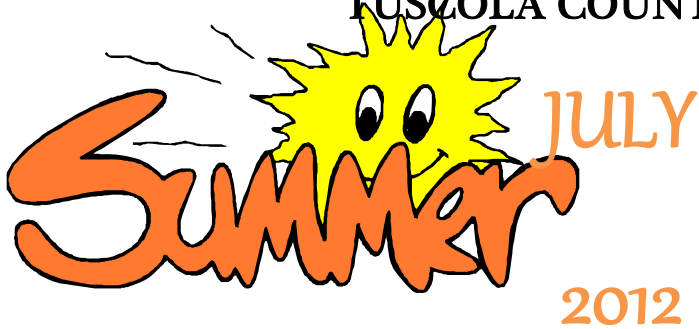


TUSCOLA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
