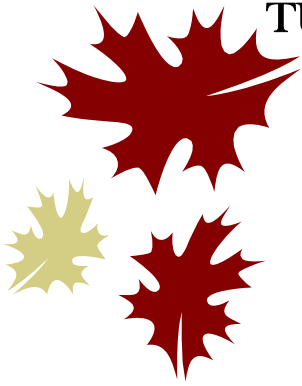

- 4th Steve Anderson was contacted by Sgt. Pierce in reference to a mercury spill that occurred in the jail booking room. Lt. Turner was also contacted and eventually contact with the health department was also made. The health dept. later tested the room and cleanup was complete.
- 5th Steve Anderson's first official day assigned as the Emergency Services Coordinator. Pat Finn and Steve attended the 2012 Region 3 Homeland Security Planning Board meeting at the Lincoln Center in Bay City.
- 6th Steve Anderson was contacted by dispatch in reference to a diesel fuel spill in the City of Vassar behind Shop Rite. I responded to the scene and found that Vassar Fire was in the process of cleaning up the spill upon my arrival. The spill was cleaned and the remaining fuel was removed from the damaged truck without incident. D.C. Lt. Speary was notified about the incident and Vassar Fire forwarded a copy of their reports to the DEQ.
- 7th Sheriff Teschendorf attended the monthly Tuscola County Chiefs of Police meeting
- 7th Steve Anderson and Pat Finn were advised of a natural gas leak at a local school after the fact. School officials evacuated the school and no further action was needed. Steve and Pat attended the Tuscola County Police Chiefs meeting at the skill center. The 3rd District State MSPEMHS radio testing was completed by dispatch (Steve could not participate because of the chiefs meeting)
- 8th Lt. Giroux attended the Tuscola County Gun Board
- 8th Steve and Pat attended the LETPA meeting at the Hampton Twp. Hall. All on duty first responders were paged for the monthly Civil Defense Test.
- 9th Sgt. Baxter attended the Thumb Narcotics Unit board meeting
- 9th Steve Anderson completed FEMA class IS-00230.b, Fundamental of Emergency Management
- 13th Sheriff Teschendorf attended the Tuscola County Fire Chiefs meeting. U/S Skrent attended the Vassar Twp. Board meeting
- 13th Steve Anderson completed FEMA class IS-00200.b, ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents. Steve also attended the Tuscola County Fire Chiefs meeting at the Caro Fire Hall.
- 14th Steve and Pat attended the All Hazards meeting and the MEMS meeting at the Health Dept. Steve and Pat also attended the TAC meeting at the Caro Police Dept.

- 16th Steve and Pat attended the Saginaw Valley Med Control Authority Meeting in Saginaw. They also dropped off several copies of the Emergency Response Guide to the Reese Fire Hall.
- 19th Sheriff Teschendorf attended the LEPC meeting. U/S Skrent attended the Millington Twp. Board meeting.
- 19th Steve and Pat met with Commissioner Bardwell at Hills and Dale Hospital. Commissioner Bardwell signed additional paperwork for Steve's appointment to the Emergency Manager position. Steve and Pat also attended LEPC meeting in the EOC room at the Sheriff's Office.
- 20th Sheriff Teschendorf attended the Caro Squadron #7 Sons of the American Legion meeting
- 20th Steve completed the LEPC grant application for 2013 and mailed it to the State Police. Brent Goodman and Steve also started portable generator located behind the jail.
- 21st Sheriff Teschendorf attended the Central Michigan Chiefs of Police meeting and Greater Thumb Area Lodge #148 FOP meeting
- 21st At 0400 hrs. Steve was notified at home of a gas/oil spill on Berger Rd near Liken Rd (TCSO complaint #1217904429). Steve responded to the scene after notifying the DEQ and found a small amount of oil/transmission fluid in the ditch that did not appear to be an immediate hazard. DEQ representatives later looked at the spill and also determined that no action was needed. Steve was advised of a semi-truck accident at Lewis Rd & Birch Run Rd in Arbela Twp. No services from this office were needed for the incident. (TCSO complaint #1217904430)
- At 0800 hrs. Steve was paged and asked to make contact with Bob Mantey the Tuscola County Drain Commissioner. Steve spoke with Mr. Mantey and learned that there was some type of foreign substance in Shay Lake near the dam. Steve contacted the DEQ and Fire Chief Mallory and advised them of the situation. Later Pat Finn and Steve responded to the spill location and made contact with District Supervisor Brian Rudolph from the DEQ. It was his determination that the substance was not petroleum based or chemical bases. After discussing the situation, the assistance of local residences, straw was placed in the creek to stop the progression of the substance from traveling further down Sucker Creek. Pat Finn and Steve took a sample of the unknown substance to the Poet Biorefining Plant in Caro where the sample was observed under a microscope and water determined to be some type of algae.
- Steve completed FEMA class IS-00120.a, An Introduction to Exercises.
- 26th Steve and Pat Finn attended Web EOC training in the Midland Law Enforcement Center. Steve also turned over his work agreement papers and appointment papers to Lt. Speary from the Michigan State Police.
- 27th Pat Finn and Steve turn over the proposed fiscal year 2013 budget to Controller Mike Hoagland
- 28th Sheriff Teschendorf, Lt. Turner and Deputy Bertsch attended the Thumb Regional Community Corrections meeting. U/S Skrent attended the Arbela Twp. Social Club luncheon
- 29th Pat Finn and Steve attended the Tuscola County Board of Commissioners meeting at the Purdy bldg.. in regard to the 2013 Fiscal Year budget for the Tuscola County Emergency Services office
- 30th Steve delivered and later picked up several portable radios at Anderson Radio that were rebanded for the Michigan State Police.
