Tuscola County Office of Emergency Management-Steve Anderson Coordinator

- December 3rd, I dropped off Caro PD's portable radio to Anderson Radio for rebanding.

Pat Finn and I attended the Region 3 Homeland Security Planning Board meeting at the Lincoln Center in Bay City.

I was paged about a three car personal injury accident on M-81 and Hurds Corner Rd.

Dispatch advised that M-81 was going to be closed because of the accident. I advised Lt Speary of the road closure.

- December 4th, I met with Corky Dean from Thumb Cellular to discuss cell phone/ air card options for the Emergency Services Office.

Four missing E.O.C. portable radios were located in the Emergency Services Office. The four radios were in need of being rebanded to continue to be operational. I took all four portables to the Bay County Road Commission Garage in Pinconning to have rebanding completed.

- December 5th, I attended "Legal issues in Emergency Management" at the Michigan State

Police Emergency Management & Homeland Security Training Facility in Lansing.

At approximately 1710 hrs, I received a call from central dispatch advising of a hydraulic fluid spill at the corner of M-25 and Sheridan Rd. I learned that dispatch received a call from MPC Environmental asking if they could close M-25 on Thursday, December 6th to clean up the spill.

I contacted the DEQ and the Fire Chief in Unionville and advised them of the situation.

On December 6th, I proceeded to the location and took several digital photos of the spill site. I then stood by while the road commission and MPC worked out the details for the cleanup. I later was contacted by Robin Oeming from the DEQ who advised that MPC was cleaning the spill up to the state's satisfaction.

- December 7th, I completed FEMA class IS-01, Emergency Program Manager-An Orientation to the Position. I also spoke with the Fire Chief from Elkland Twp, Glen Guilds about a portable radio that was assigned to his department that did not get rebanded. I discussed the importance of getting radio rebanded and that if the radio was not rebanded, it would not be operational after the first of the year. After discussing the situation, Chief Guilds advised me that he would take the radio to Muskegon on Tuesday, December 11* for rebanding. (This radio was the last radio in the county that had not been rebanded.)

At approximately 1530 hrs, I received a phone call from Gene Ellison, the Fire Chief & DPW superintendent in the Village of Reese. Ellison advised that they found a diesel fuel spill in the Reese Drain and that he was in the process of putting out booms to catch the spill.

- On December 7th, at approximately 1610 hrs, I was notified of a possible gas or some type of unknown gas inside a residence in Cass City that was causing the occupants eyes to burn. Cass City police and Elkland Twp fire department handled the situation and found that the furnace was the source of the problem.

- December 10th, I delivered the rebanded Denmark Twp Police portable to Chief Hecht at his office in Richville.

- On December 12th, Pat Finn and I attended the All Hazards and MEMS meetings at the Tuscola County Health Department. We also attended the Citizen Corps Council Committee meeting at the Bay County EOC-911 Center.

December 13th, all on duty first responders were paged for the monthly Civil Defense test. I also attended the Tuscola County Firefighters Association meeting at the Caro Fire Hall.

December 14th, I participated in the WEB EOC load test to see if the program can withstand a large amount of people on the system at one time. I also attended the Third District Christmas party in Bay City.

December 17th, while watching the morning news, I learned that Cass City Public Schools were closed because of a threat that a student made. I did not receive any notification from Cass City Schools or the Cass City Police Department. I called Director Klenk and also learned that he was not made aware of the incident that was unfolding in Cass City. He advised me that he had contacted Chief Haynes about the situation because of the large number of calls dispatch was receiving about the incident. Chief Haynes advised that he had everything under control.

I then proceeded to Tuscola County Central Dispatch and made contact with Director Klenk and supervisors Neilson and Summerset. We discussed the incident with the limited knowledge that we had. I also received a phone call from Lt. Speary and I updated her on the situation and the failure of Cass City Schools and Cass City Police contacting the appropriate agencies about the incident.

While at dispatch I also learned that the Skill Center was on lockdown and Mayville Public Schools was on a "Soft" lockdown.

During the course of the day, I met with Chief Lich from the Kingston Police Department and we discussed active shooter responses and school mapping. Chief Lich was also given a CD with all of the school maps for the county.

December 18th, at approximately 0745 hrs, I received information that Millington Schools had received a threats complaint involving guns and or a bomb. I made contact with Assistant Chief Tom Laude and asked if he needed any assistance. Asst. Chief Laude stated that he did. Detective Jones and I then proceeded to the Millington High School. While enroute to the school, I made contact with Lt. Speary and advised her of the situation. Lt. Speary made arrangements to have a bomb dog placed on standby in the event that it would be needed. I also requested a bomb dog from M.S.P. and Trooper Escort arrived and swept the interior and exterior of the high school with nil results.

- On December 18th, the Tuscola County Skill Center was operating in "Secure in Place" mode.

On December 18th, at approximately 1540 hrs, I was contacted by the Elkland Twp Fire Chief Gene Guilds in reference to a fuel spill at an accident involving two trucks on Bay City Forestville Rd near Koepfgen Rd. Elkland Fire advised that they would clean the spill.

- On December 19th Skill Center still operating in the "Secure in Place" mode.
- On December 20th, Skill Center operating in "Secure in Place" mode. I spoke with Lt. Speary of the Michigan State Police and with Lt. Lounsbury from the Saginaw County Office of Emergency Management about the recent events that transpired at the Cass City Schools and Millington High School.

I received a call from Deputy Nitz advising that there was a car in the ditch leaking fuel on Barkley Rd near Swaffer Rd.) In talking with Deputy Nitz it was determined that the vehicle that was involved in the crash had only leaked a small amount of fuel into the creek and no further action was needed.

Deputies Hook, Kinney, Nitz, Pisha, and I along with Assist Chief Laude performed a walk through at the Millington High School with Principal Bearss and a school board member to familiarize ourselves with the building and to point out any safety concerns.

- December 21st, the Skill Center operating in "Secure in Place" mode.
- December 28th, I completed F.Y. 2013 quarterly report for the Michigan State Police. 26th Steve and Pat Finn attended Web EOC training in the Midland Law Enforcement Center. Steve also turned over his work agreement papers and appointment papers to Lt. Speary from the Michigan State Police.
- 27th Pat Finn and Steve turn over the proposed fiscal year 2013 budget to Controller Mike Hoagland
- 28th Sheriff Teschendorf, Lt. Turner and Deputy Bertsch attended the Thumb Regional Community Corrections meeting. U/S Skrent attended the Arbela Twp. Social Club luncheon
- 29th Pat Finn and Steve attended the Tuscola County Board of Commissioners meeting at the Purdy bldg.. in regard to the 2013 Fiscal Year budget for the Tuscola County Emergency Services office

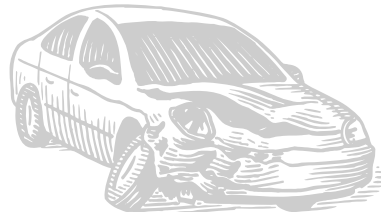

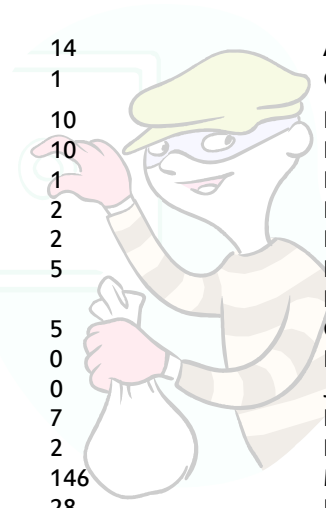
