February 4th, I attended the Michigan 3rd District Regional Homeland Security Planning Board meeting at the Lincoln Center in Bay City.

- February 12th, I met with Millington School Officials and the Millington Police Chief to discuss safety improvements that school is working on.
- February 13th, I attended and helped facilitate the Tuscola County All Hazards and MEMS meeting at the Tuscola County Health Department. I also met with Jay Eickholt from the Michigan State Police at the Saginaw County EOC to discuss SARA properties.
- February 14th, I attended the Citizens Corps Council meeting at the Bay County EOC and also the LETPA meeting at the Hampton Twp Hall with Undersheriff Skrent.
- February 18th, I attended and helped facilitate the LEPC meeting at the Tuscola County EOC.
- February 21st, I attended the Tuscola County Fire Association meeting at the Elmwood Fire Department in Gagetown.
- February 25th, I was called to assist Vassar Fire and Deputy Roland at a house fire on Maple Rd in Vassar Twp. Deputy Roland arrived on location and learned that the house contained a large stockpile of ammo and possibly some grenades. I arrived on location and Deputy Roland and I talked to a subject who resided at the residence. She advised that there was a large safe in the house that was full of rifle ammo. She also told us that there were several ammo cans in the same room that also contained ammo, CS gas, and red smoke. After learning where the items were in the house, I advised Chief Millerov. After the fire was extinguished, firemen checked the room and located several military ammo cans that were either full of ammo or military grade smoke grenades. I made contact with Sgt. Bekemeier from the Michigan State Police Bomb Squad and advised him of the situation. He then responded to the scene and was able to

take possession of four canisters of military grade CS gas and a dummy "pineapple" style grenade.

- February 26th, Sheriff Teschendorf, Lt Speary, Mark Reene, and I co-facilitated a meeting with local first responders and school superintendents at the Skill Center. The meeting was put on to discuss school incidents and what the response would be from first responders in Tuscola County.
