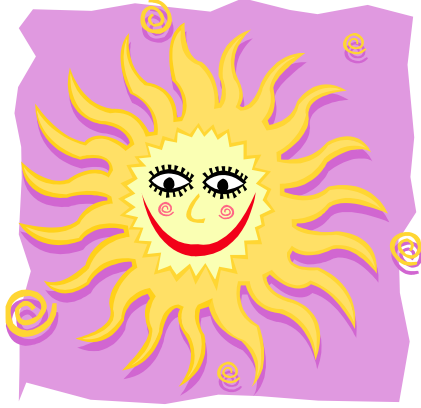


**TUSCOLA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

The project that was approved was the purchase of several additional portable radios and accessories with a value of just over \$58,000.00.

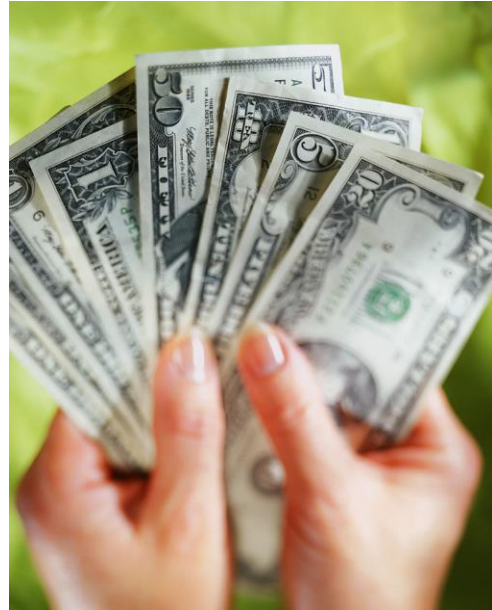
