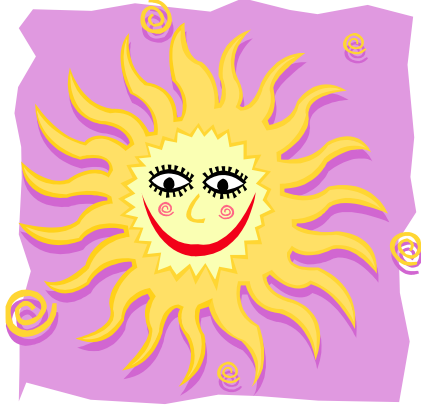

2013

- 1 Steve Anderson picked up copies of the school "Active Incident Plans" from the ISD who agreed to print 30 copies for area first responders. That afternoon Steve attended the R3HSPB meeting at the Midland Law Enforcement Center.
- 2 Steve Anderson met with David Gaines, the Site Safety Coordinator for Blattner Energy (Company hired to erect windmills for Nextera)
- 3 Tornado Siren testing was completed for the month with eight of the 13 departments verifying that they completed the testing.
- 8 Steve was paged at home in regards to a PIA Accident on Fairgrove Rd near Sheridan Rd. He responded to the location and made contact with Deputy Whetstone and Fairgrove Fire and learned that one of the cars involved was leaking fuel. Incident was cleaned up and no further action was needed.
- 9 U/S Skrent attended the Tuscola County Sheriff's Office Mounted division meeting.
- 9 Steve Anderson attended the Tuscola County Fire Chief's meeting at the Caro Fire Hall.
- 10 Sheriff Leland Teschendorf attended the Tuscola Behavioral Health Systems training center open house.
- 10 Steve Anderson attended and helped to facilitate the Tuscola County All Hazard's meeting at the Tuscola County Health Department. He also participated in the state 800 MHz radio test for Region #3. That afternoon Steve went to Gagetown to photograph the proposed siren location so he could complete the needed paperwork for the grant process.
- 11 Steve Anderson attended the Citizen Council Corps meeting at the Saginaw County EOC.
- 11 Sheriff Leland Teschendorf attended the monthly Tuscola County Gun Board meeting.
- 12 Steve Anderson attended the Region 3 district meeting at Steve Leese's residence (Mr. Leese is the former 911 Director/Emergency Manager for Huron County and now works for APCO)

- 16 Tuscola County and several surrounding counties are under a Heat Advisory Warning until July 18th.
- 17 Steve Anderson facilitated the Tuscola County Citizen Corps Advisory Council which was held in the EOC room. He also helped Lt. Speary with the second WebEOC class for the EOC staff. After the WebEOC class, Steve facilitated a "Hot Wash" for the Akron Fairgrove Active Shooter Training that was held on June 7th.
- 17 Sheriff Leland Teschendorf attended the Citizens Emergency Response Team meeting.
- 18 Steve Anderson attended the National Improvised Explosives Familiarization Training in Howell. That evening he attended the Tuscola County Fire Association meeting at the MMR base in Vassar.
- 19 Steve Anderson was asked to cover Sanilac County for Todd Hillman (Sanilac County's E.M.) who was going to be out of the state for the weekend. At 1445 hrs, Tuscola County was placed under a severe thunderstorm warning until 1545 hrs. The storm hit northern Tuscola County resulting in several down trees, an overturned semi on M-24 just south of Unionville, and power outages in several areas. During the time of the storm, dispatch was inundated with calls and the paging system failed. Steve proceeded to dispatch and assisted in paging fire departments manually during the height of the storm. (From 1415 hrs to 2215 hrs, Tuscola County Central Dispatch handled 33 traffic hazards, 47 wires down calls, 2 Property Damage Accidents, 1 unknown accident, 2 Personal Injury Accidents, and fielded 2 calls from people looking for gas.) At approximately 1616 hrs, Steve received a call from Sanilac County asking for me to call the Deckerville Fire Chief, Tracy Hass. He called Chief Hass and learned that the Deckerville area was also hit by the storm and suffered down trees and wires with scattered power outages.
- 22 Steve Anderson attended a meeting with a FEMA representative at the Saginaw County EOC. grant money available to counties in Michigan to update their Hazard Mitigation Plan. The grant application for that process was started. That afternoon he met with Donna Fraczek, the Tuscola County Court Administrator to talk about a court house emergency response plan.
- 23 Lt. Giroux attended the Substance Abuse Prevention coalition meeting.
- 25 Steve Anderson attended the Tuscola County Board of Commissioners meeting to discuss funding FY2011 & FY 2012 Homeland Security grants. After talking about the issues regarding funding, the board agreed to fund the purchase of allocated Homeland Security items with the understanding that the associated costs would be reimbursed by the Federal Government.
That afternoon, Undersheriff Skrent and Steve Anderson met with Shelly LLiff the Public Awareness Coordinator for Enbridge. She presented the Tuscola County Office of Emergency Management with a check for \$1250.00 for equipment from Enbridge.
- 26 Steve Anderson received a page at 0727 hrs asking for me to contact Assistant Chief Linal Baur from the Fairgrove Fire Dept. He returned his call and learned that they were currently at a house fire at 3150 Gilford Rd and as a result of the fire the structure was not safe and they needed the structure taken down. Steve also learned that because of the nature of the fire, a fire investigator from the state was called in.

Steve Anderson responded to the scene and made contact with Assistant Chief Baur and Spl/Sgt Lenny Jaskulka from the Michigan State Police Fire Investigation Unit. Spl/Sgt Jaskulka advised that the residence was not safe and because of that no one could enter the house. (Fire was still burning in the roof area of the residence which was completely gutted by the fire. After discussing the issue, it was decided that Assistant Chief Baur would contact a local excavator to have the residence razed. Monchilov Excavating was then contacted and arrived on location and razed the building which allowed the fire department to finish extinguishing the blaze.

26 Sheriff Leland Teschendorf attended the Thumb Narcotics Unit board meeting.

30 Steve met with Keith Wetters, the new superintendent at Reese Public Schools, and the administrators from all of the Reese Public School buildings to discuss safety plans for the district.

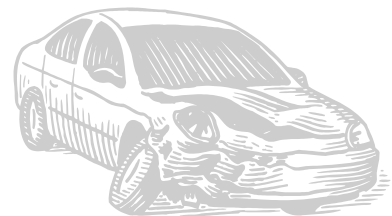

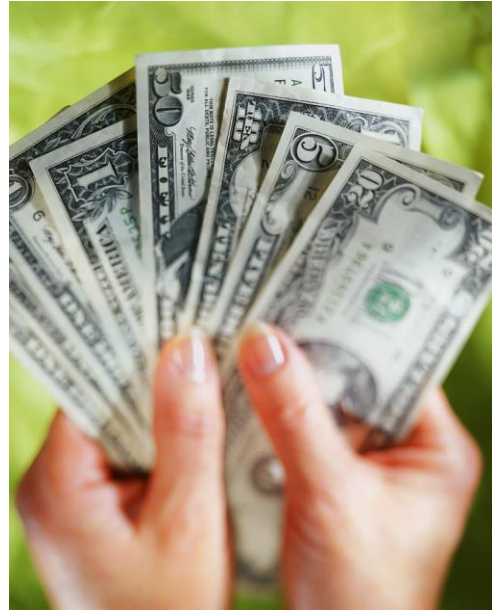
