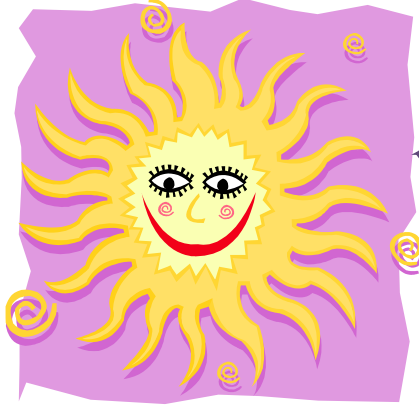

2013

- 1st Sharon Mika and Steve Anderson completed a tour of one of the SNS sites in Tuscola County.
- 5th Sheriff Teschendorf attended the Caro Rotary Club meeting with Det. Scott Jones who made a presentation regarding senior frauds and scams.
- Steve Anderson attended the Region 3 Homeland Security Planning Board Meeting at the Midland Law Enforcement Complex.
- 6th Steve Anderson attended the Local Emergency Coordinating Committee Meeting at Radio Center in Saginaw to finalize the Emergency Broadcast plan for Region 3. That afternoon he met with Fred Hecht and picked up the 800 MHz state radio that was issued to Denmark Twp through a Homeland Security grant.
- 7th Steve Anderson attended the FEMA class "Fostering Resilience: A whole community effort" workshop at the Oakland Community College in Auburn Hills. Southern Tuscola County was under a Severe Thunderstorm Warning from 0620 to 0715 hrs.
- Tuscola County fire departments also tested their tornado sirens that morning at 1000 hrs. Tuscola County also participated in the Region 3 state radio test at 1100 hrs.
- 8th Undersheriff Skrent attended the monthly Tuscola County Gun Board.
- 13th Steve Anderson attended "Advanced Floodplain Management Concept course which was presented by FEMA at Mid-Michigan College in Clare.
- 14th Undersheriff Skrent attended the Tuscola County TRIAD meeting.
- Sheriff Teschendorf attended a meeting at the Michigan Sheriff's Association office regarding proposed changes in the method of providing county jail inspections.
- Steve Anderson drove to the following schools to make contact with school administrators: Christ the King Lutheran School in Unionville, Deford Christian Academy, and Juniata Christian School. During the meetings, he was able to gather needed school information for the "Tuscola County Active Incident Plans" that will be used in case there is an emergency at any of the schools in Tuscola County.

- 15th Steve Anderson attended the Citizen Corps Council meeting at Harry Browne airport in Saginaw. After the meeting, he was able to get the Tuscola County CERT team some equipment out of the Region 3 supply which is stored at the airport. That afternoon, Steve attended the LETPA meeting at the Hampton Twp Hall.
- 16th Steve Anderson attended the Tuscola County Board of Commissioners meeting at the Purdy building. While at the meeting he asked the board for approval to seek grant funds to update the county's hazard mitigation plan (Board approved request). Later that morning, Steve attended the Saginaw Valley Med Control meeting in Saginaw where house bill #4785 was discussed. That afternoon he emailed the Michigan State Police EMHSD Tuscola County's Notice of Intent to apply.
- 19th A tour of Thumb MRI in Cass City was done by Emergency Service Manager, Steve Anderson, Sheriff Teschendorf, law enforcement and emergency managers from Sanilac and Huron counties to develop emergency procedures for the facility.
- 20th Sheriff Teschendorf participated in the "Truckin Tuesday" event for youngsters at the Rawson Memorial Library in Cass City. He also attended the Caro Squadron #7 Sons of the American Legion meeting.
- Steve Anderson submitted the Hazard Mitigation Grant to the State of Michigan. (If selected, grant will be used to update the Tuscola County Hazard Mitigation Plan which expires shortly) That evening Steve was paged for a PIA semi accident on M-138 and Vassar Rd. He arrived on location and made contact with Fairgrove Fire and Chief Scarborough from the Akron Police Department. Steve learned that a semi had been run off the roadway and ended up jack knifed in the ditch, rupturing the fuel tank in the process. He found that there was no immediate threat and on August 21st, I made contact with DEQ representatives from the DEQ office in Bay City. Steve then met with Robin Oeming from the DEQ at the crash scene. Upon inspection of the site, it was determined that no further action would be needed to clean up the spilled diesel fuel.
- 21st At the request of Chief Scarborough and other emergency personnel, Steve Anderson made contact with Michelle Zawerucha at the Tuscola County Road Commission and asked about the routing of the windmill truck traffic. Michelle advised that the decision to have the oversized loads travel M83-M15-M138 was made by MDOT in Lansing. He explained that Fairgrove Rd was very narrow and there had been two accidents involving truck traffic on M138 (Fairgrove Rd) in two days. That afternoon, Steve met with Robert Hiiter and Elaine Ross-Fiorillo who picked up CERT equipment that was received from the Region 3 inventory.
